Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or when limits are reached, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, in season, excused by the Veterinarian, or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, snowstorms, or hurricanes), or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refunds of entry fees will be made.

Closing Date: Wednesday, September 17, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed and must be at the address of the Trial Secretary. No telegraph, telephone, faxed, unsigned or incomplete entries will be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopies of forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Checks returned by the bank for non-sufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25 collection fee will be added to the amount of each check returned.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Please type or hand-write neatly on entries. Acknowledgement of acceptance of entry shall occur a few days after receipt of entry by email. Formal confirmation and judging schedule will arrive by both by US mail and email (when email contact provided). If you do not receive either a pre-trial acknowledgement of receipt or a confirmation, contact the trial secretary immediately.

Exhibitor's Information

Dogs should be at the trial site before their scheduled judging time. Judging will begin promptly.

Trial Facilities

All obedience and rally rings are expected to be outdoors on grass. All Obedience rings will have babygates. Rally rings will be two-strand ring tape with ring stancions or baby gates.

Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles

Even with the windows rolled down two inches or more, the heat can become intense and cause brain damage! The club will not be responsible for damage to cars resulting from the rescue of overheated animals!

If you require disabled parking or special accommodations, include a note to the trial secretary with your entry describing any assistance you may require.

Breakfast goodies and coffee will be available in the morning. Various fast food and sandwich shops are located in Roseville and food vendors will be on site Saturday and Sunday.

Trial Rules

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed on the show grounds. All dogs must be kept on leash within the show limits unless in the ring.

Catalogs will be provided for exhibitors.
